Jackson Hankia Kilgore, age 72, died at home March 13, 2008. He was born April 19, 1935 in Meadowview, VA to John Bascombe Kilgore and Virginia Ernestine Hankia.

After high school, he entered the Air Force where he flew & maintained helicopters. He served in Okinawa, Japan, Vietnam, Thailand and numerous stateside bases. He was a High Priest and faithfully served in numerous Church callings over the years.
